

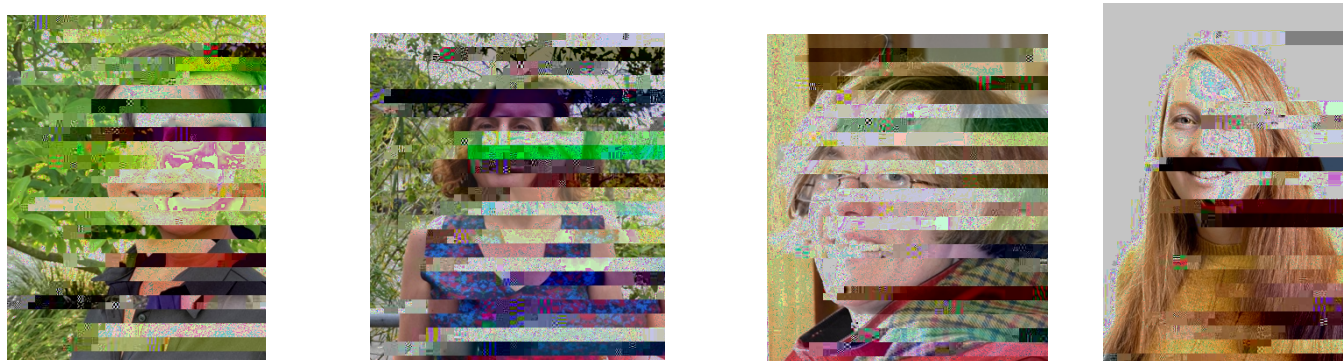


Avanti Park School Safeguarding - parent information newsletter
